SUBJECT: ABOUT HEALTH QUALITY ONTARIO?

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Health Quality Ontario (HQO) is the provincial government advisor on the quality of health care. They work in partnership with health care providers and organizations across the system, and engage with patients themselves, to help initiate substantial and sustainable change to the province's complex health system.

Frequently, they take on research and provide grants that relate to CASLPO members' practice. For example, HQO currently is:

- surveying stakeholders regarding Cochlear Implant service enhancements (<http://www.hqontario.ca/evidence-to-improve-care/health-technology-assessment/reviews-and-recommendations/bilateral-cochlear-implantation>)
