The province launched the Ontario Health Workforce Matching Portal that will help match skilled frontline workers with employers. Access the [Full News Release](#).

The Ministry of Health is looking for healthcare providers who are not currently working, working part-time and want to and are prepared to increase their work hours, or former healthcare providers who are retired, or on inactive status with their regulatory college; and are prepared to return to employment.

Before submitting an application to the portal, those interested are asked to please read all of the relevant material accessible below, including the [FAQs](#).

Former CASLPO members who are retired, or members who are currently non-practising, who wish to volunteer their services to the Government should contact [CASLPO's Director of Registration Services](#) for **information about reinstating** your general certificate of registration.

Interested health care professionals and employers can [visit the portal here](#) and create a profile with [Ontario's Health Workforce Matching Portal](#). Once registered, professionals can add their availability and employers can enter their request for support. Registrants will receive an email notification if matched.

If you are selected, you will be contacted directly by the Ontario Government with further direction. CASLPO is not involved in selecting and deploying health professionals.
